Hello from Eunhye! We had missions reality team from WOLBI NY in Taiwan for a week! We did children's camp, English café ministry, and promoting SYME ministry and so one. It was a lot of fun! But at the same time, It was the time that the mission team can actually see the need of the Gospel in Taiwan by seeing a lot of temples on the streets and people who are bowing their head down before the idol statues.

Hallelujah! I have excellent news for you ☺

Guan, a Taiwanese guy, used to come to SYME to join English café every Monday night. He is actually interested in Korean more than English. And his Korean is like almost his mother tongue!

So we talked in Korean sometimes. A few weeks ago, after the English class, I asked him if he goes to church. He said "Sometimes." I asked him again if he considers himself as a Christian. He said, "I am a 'kind of' Christian." I asked why. He told me three reasons why he thinks he is a 'kind of' Christian. First, He does not go to church every Sunday. Second, he does not pray often. Third, He is not baptized yet. Hearing those made me sigh.



We cannot be saved by “attending” church, “praying” often, or “being” baptized.

We cannot be saved by our “works.” If we were able to be saved by our own “works,” Jesus did not have to die for our sin. Whole Gospel becomes meaningless. The Bible clearly tells us about salvation.

John 3:16 For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life.

Ephesians 2:8-9 For it is by grace you have been saved, through faith and this not from yourselves, this is the gift of God not by works so that no one can boast.

Jesus came to us, died on the cross, and resurrected after three days to clean our sins and restore our relationship between Him and us. By believing it, we have the right to become His children. If we make the fire at the fireplace, smokes come out from the chimney. If we have faith in God, our deeds come out of us as we mature in Him. We put our efforts to be more like Jesus, to love Him more, and to please Him.

I told Guan how much Jesus loves him and we read the scriptures together. Praise the Lord, Guan clearly understood what the Gospel really means and what the genuine love of Jesus is. He was confident about his salvation. I left him the address of my church, and he went back home. I didn't even forget that I gave him the address.

Next Sunday, after the service, I saw him seated on the back seat shyly alone. I was so thankful that God brought him to the church. Please pray for Guan that he can continue to come to church to grow as a firm believer!



Please keep praying for Irene. She is leaving SYME after the first week of May. She does understand what the Gospel means and know that God loves her. However, she is not taking her last step to be a Christian. She is not sure if she loves God. Her heart is indeed stirred and overwhelmed by His love. I feel sad to see her not taking her step out to become His child. She came to SYME only to learn English, but her life is changing through the Word of God. I can see that God loves her so much! I do not know what confuses her so much, but He knows, and He is touching her heart! Pray for me that I can continue to share His love with her and Irene can one day take His love as hers.
